Annwyl rieni/Dear parents,

Rwy'n gobeithio bo chi a'ch teulu yn llwyddo i gadw'n iach ac yn ddiogel.

Wrth bo fi'n ysgrifennu'r llythyr yma, mae Kirsty Williams, ein Gweinidog Addysg yn siarad am ei chynllun ar gyfer sut i ddychwelyd ein lleoliadau addysgol, a'r cynllun yw i gadw at y pum egwyddor allweddol nododd hi ryw bythefnos yn ôl, gan ddefnyddio system goleuadau traffig i asesu cynnydd ein gwlad. Mae'n galonogol iawn i ni yng Nghymru bod ein gweinidog Addysg yn ymgynghori'n eang cyn symud unrhyw gynlluniau ar gyfer dychwelyd ymlaen. Mae'r ymgynghoriad hwn yn cynnwys chi a'ch plant, felly defnyddiwch eich llais a chwblhewch yr holiadur wnes i rannu ar ran y sir yr wythnos diwethaf yn gofyn am eich barn. Mae Llywodraeth Cymru hefyd yn awyddus i glywed wrth ein disgyblion, felly defnyddiwch y ddolen isod i gynnig barn eich plentyn hefyd.

Ar gyfer yr wythnos nesaf hoffem roi cyfle i bawb "ddal i fyny"! Bydd hyn yn rhoi cyfle i bob teulu edrych ar y tri set o heriau a osodwyd a'r holl waith Rhifedd a Llythrennedd a osodwyd a cheisio gorffen cymaint â phosibl a'i rannu gyda'r athrawon er mwyn i'ch plentyn derbyn adborth cyn i ni symud mewn i hanner tymor.

Bydd wythnos nesaf hefyd yn rhoi amser i ddisgyblion y dosbarth Pinc a Melyn i ddal i fyny gyda'r defnydd o Lexia, RM Maths a Big Maths - cyfle i fynd yn ôl at y pethau sylfaenol, i ddarllen ac i ddysgu tablau a ffeithiau rhif. Ar gyfer y Melyn a Phinc, mae hwn yn gyfle da i dreulio amser ar Lexia bob dydd ac i wella tablau trwy roi cynnig ar ddefnyddio J2Blast bob dydd. Bydd pob disgybl yn dal i gael e-bost ar fore Dydd Llun yn eu hatgoffa o'r hyn sydd gyda nhw i wneud, ond gorffen gwaith ac ymarfer darllen a thablau bydd y neges. Felly cyfle i bawb i anadlu tamaid!

Rwy'n siŵr bod darllen eich plentyn yn bryder i lawer ohonoch chi. Fel ysgol, nid yw'n ymarferol i ni fod yn rhannu llyfrau darllen rhwng teuluoedd, ond mae yna lawer o adnoddau ar gael i chi fel rhieni. Rwyf wedi rhannu'r adnoddau hyn eto ar ddiwedd y llythyr yma. Os oes gennych unrhyw ofidion penodol ynglŷn â darllen, yna e-bostiwch yr athrawes dosbarth, neu rhowch wybod iddynt pan fyddant yn gwneud eu galwadau ffôn rheolaidd. Rwy'n siŵr y byddant yn gallu eich cyfeirio at adnoddau pwrpasol.

Os ydych wedi bod yn defnyddio'r llyfr gwaith aeth allan rhyw 7 wythnos yn ôl a'ch bod yn rhedeg allan o le, yna cysylltwch â ni a gallwn drefnu bod llyfr arall ar gael yn yr ysgol i chi.

Os yw'ch plentyn yn derbyn gwersi cerdd yn yr ysgol gan un o'n athrawon peripatetig, yna dylent gadw llygad am e-bost yn darparu dysgu ar-lein iddynt ar gyfer ei offeryn, unwaith eto rwyf wedi atodi'r manylion isod.

Cofiwch ein bod ni'n gweithio trwy'r profiad yma fel tîm, os oes unrhyw beth y gallwn ei wneud i'ch cefnogi ymhellach, yna hoffem eich helpu os yn bosib.

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I hope this letter finds you well and that you and your family are managing to stay safe.

As I write Kirsty Williams, our Minister for Education is speaking about her plan for the return of educational settings, and that plan is to stick to the five key principles she set out some two weeks ago using a traffic light system to assess the country's progress. It is very reassuring for us in Wales that our Education minister is consulting widely before moving any plans for return forward. This consultation includes you and your children, so please use your voice and complete the questionnaire circulated by myself on behalf of the county last week, asking for your opinion. The Welsh Government are also keen to hear from our pupils, so please make use of the link provided to offer your child's opinion.

For next week we would like to give everybody the chance to just "catch-up"! This will give all families the chance to look at the three sets of challenges that have been set and all of the Numeracy and Literacy work set and try to finish as much as possible. Please share this with your child's teacher so that feedback can be given before we reach half term.

This should also give everyone time to catch up with their use of Lexia, RM Maths and Big Maths - a chance to get back to basics, to read and to learn tables and number facts. For the Dosbarth Melyn and Pinc, this would be a good chance to spend time on Lexia every day and to improve your tables by having a go at using J2Blast every day. Each pupil will still get an email on Monday morning reminding them of what we would like them to do, but it will be finishing work, reading and tables practise. A chance to breathe!

I'm sure your child's reading is a concern for many of you. As a school it is still not practical for us to be circulating reading books between families, however there are many resources available to you as parents, as we have been sharing all along. I have shared these resources again at the end of this letter. Making use of "Paired Reading" as a strategy is a very useful way of encouraging our more reluctant readers - have a go! (See below). If you have any particular concerns, then please email the class teacher, or let them know when they make their regular phonecalls. I'm sure they will be able to point you in the right direction.

If you have been using the exercise book provided and you are running out of space, then please get in touch and we can arrange for another book to be made available.

If your child receives music lessons at school from one of our peripatetic teachers then they should keep an eye out for an email providing them with on line learning for their instrument, again I have attached the details below.

Please remember that we are working through this experience as a team, if there is anything that we can do to support you further, then we would like to help if at all possible.

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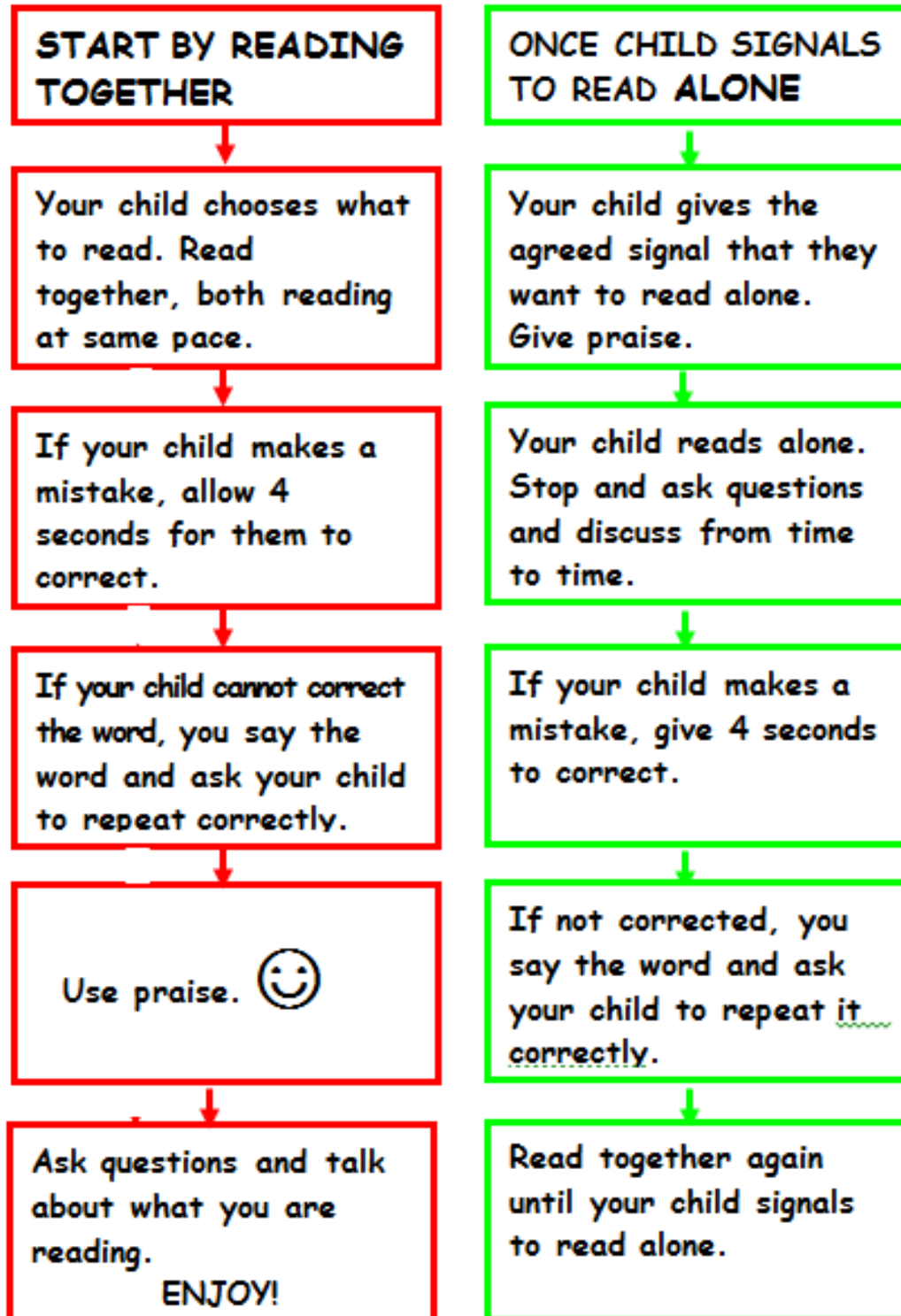

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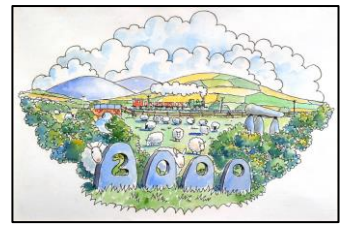
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
