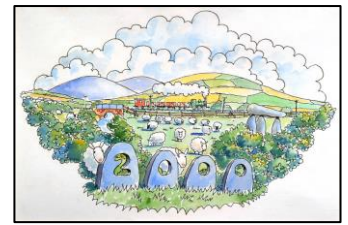

Dear Parents,

Considering none of us have ever taken a course entitled "Surviving Lockdown and Home schooling", I think we have managed remarkably well so far! Thank you again for your support to us as a school. I would also like to take this opportunity to thank the staff for their team work, and for going the extra mile to make sure that our pupils' work has been planned carefully, differentiated, posted on line and marked whilst they have also had the additional challenge of teaching their own children, and like us all, providing a seemingly endless stream of meals!

Even though we have survived like this for 9 weeks now, we still seem to be living with the same list of worries, our logistics regarding work, childcare, financial worries, health worries, elderly relatives, small children, teenagers... Then we add to this mix the news updates and the non-stop notifications and often nonsense on social media and wonder why we are unable to sleep! However, as the Welsh government start to formulate a traffic light recovery plan, there is hope that very gradually, over the coming weeks, our world will begin to return to a new normal. As I have said before, as yet we don't know what this normal will look like, but as soon as we have a timescale and guidelines to work to, we will be able to inform you of what this will mean to you as a family.

Next week is half term. This break is much needed by staff and pupils alike, but also for you as parents. Please make sure that the children have some free time so that it feels like half term. This is really important, as following next week there will be a whole new set of tasks waiting. Setting the correct amount of work for everyone during this time has been impossible, engagement has varied hugely. Some parents want more work, because their child finishes everything between 8 and 8:30am. Some parents want less, because their children want a lie in and want to do the minimum. Some parents are working long hours themselves and are finding supporting the home learning a real challenge. I do hope that this "catch-up" week and the break over half term will provide you with a timely rest so that following the half term break everyone will be inspired to re-engage with all of the tasks set. We really do want to be able to reach out to all of our pupils.

If you have any feedback, then please let us know, we have carefully listened to any comments that have come in so far. If you have any work that has been completed at home that you can email or post to us using your phone camera,

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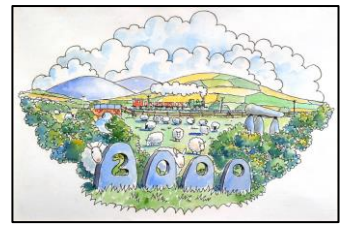
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this is all helpful, as we then know which children have managed to complete which tasks.
