The **Welsh Language Charter** was introduced as part of the Government initiative to secure **1 million Welsh** speakers by 2050.

What is the Welsh Language Charter? The Welsh Language Charter aims to positively influence children's use of Welsh socially. In short, to get the children to **speak** Welsh naturally among themselves. Since the launch of the Charter in 2017, very good work has gone on in our school. The Welsh Language Charter requires the involvement of all members of the school community - the School Dragons, all the **pupils**, the workforce, **parents**, governors and the wider community in order to ensure full ownership.

How can I help to **improve** my child's **Welsh** language skills?

Play **Welsh music** at home whenever possible - eg listen to **Cyw** or **Trac yr Mythnos** playlists in the bath/in the car/parties/sleepovers.

Participate in **Welsh activities** outside school - sports/drama/art clubs etc run by **Menter Iaith** and encourage them to **use their Welsh at all times.**

Encourage your child to see that Welsh is more than just the language of school work. Try to help them see they can also **enjoy** themselves in Welsh!

Encourage them to watch **Welsh tv** programmes on **S4C** as it helps develop vocabulary while it entertains!
